THE APPLICATION

Be concise and to the point. Make sure you outline clearly what you are applying for and how it will benefit your Club/group.

Applications are most likely to be approved if supporting quotes are enclosed. Inflated budgets are easy to spot.

Fill in the whole form. Incomplete applications indicate a lack of thought and commitment, and are therefore unlikely to be considered.

If there are other deserving applications containing all the necessary information, then we may not follow up missing information.

Applications don't have to be typed, but if they're not easily read they probably won't be considered.

Late applications will not be considered.

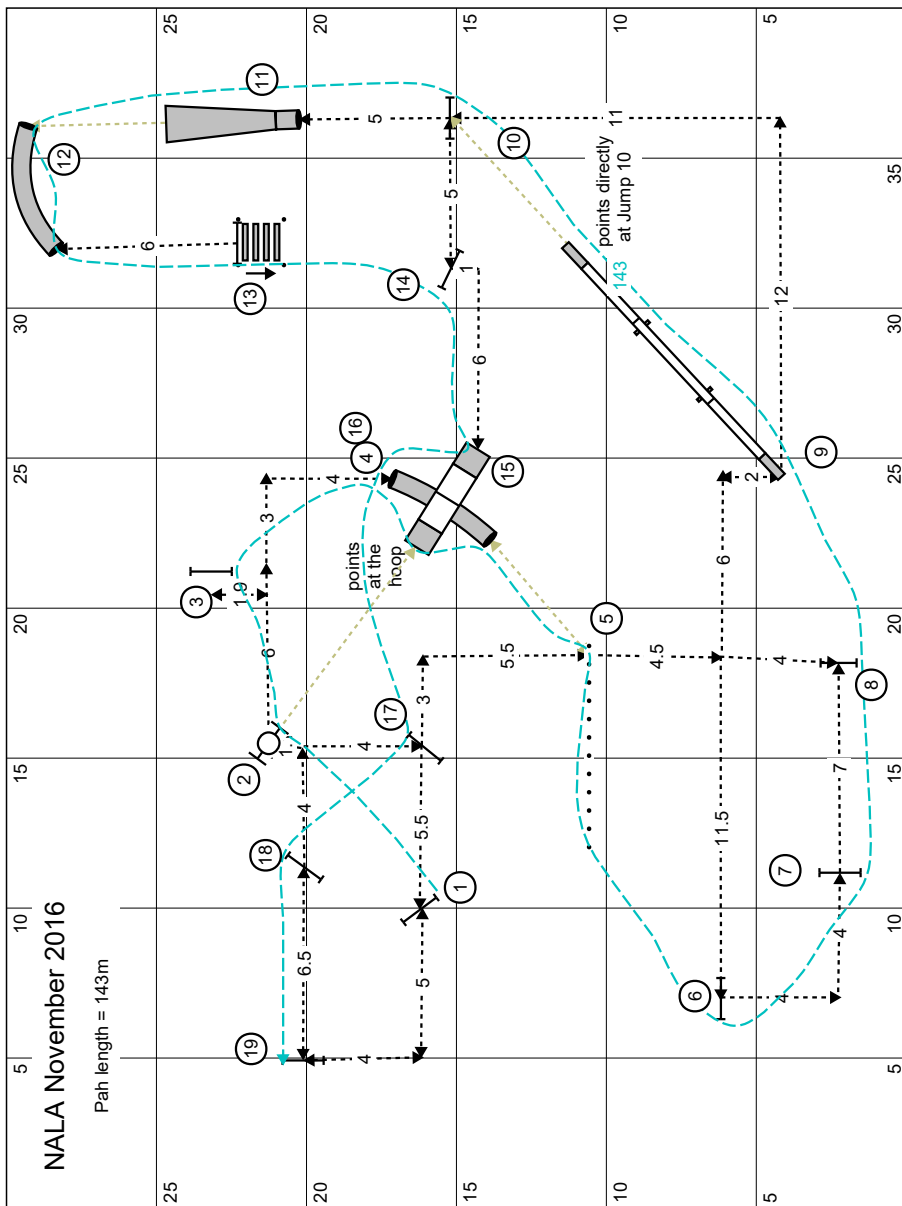

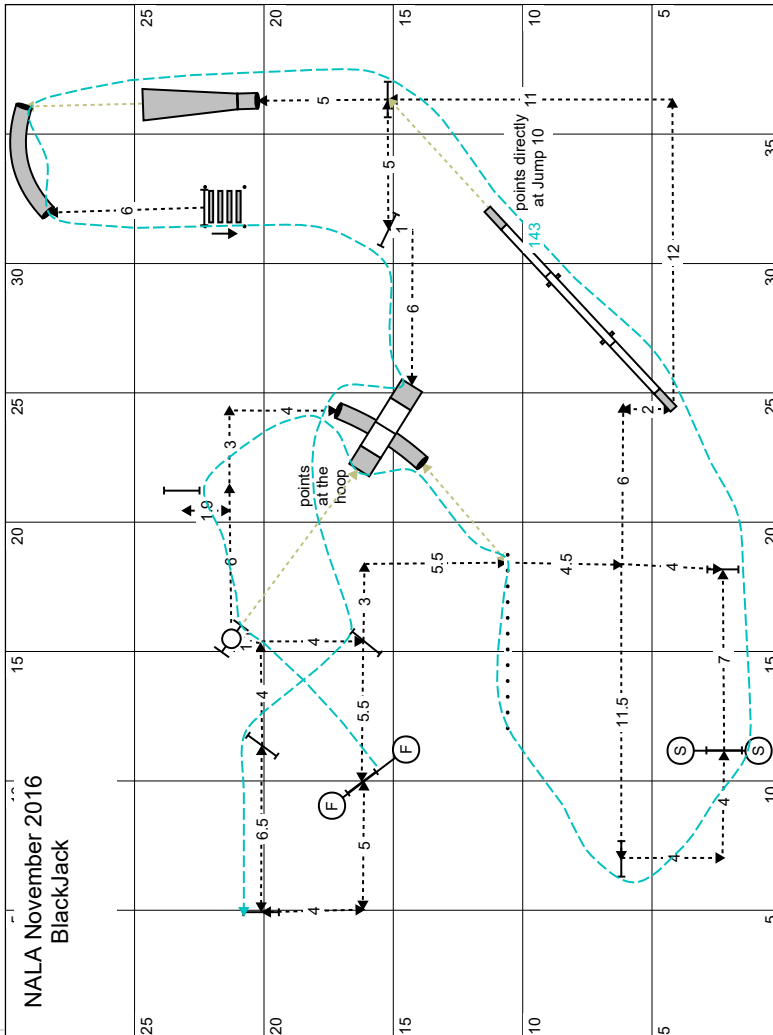

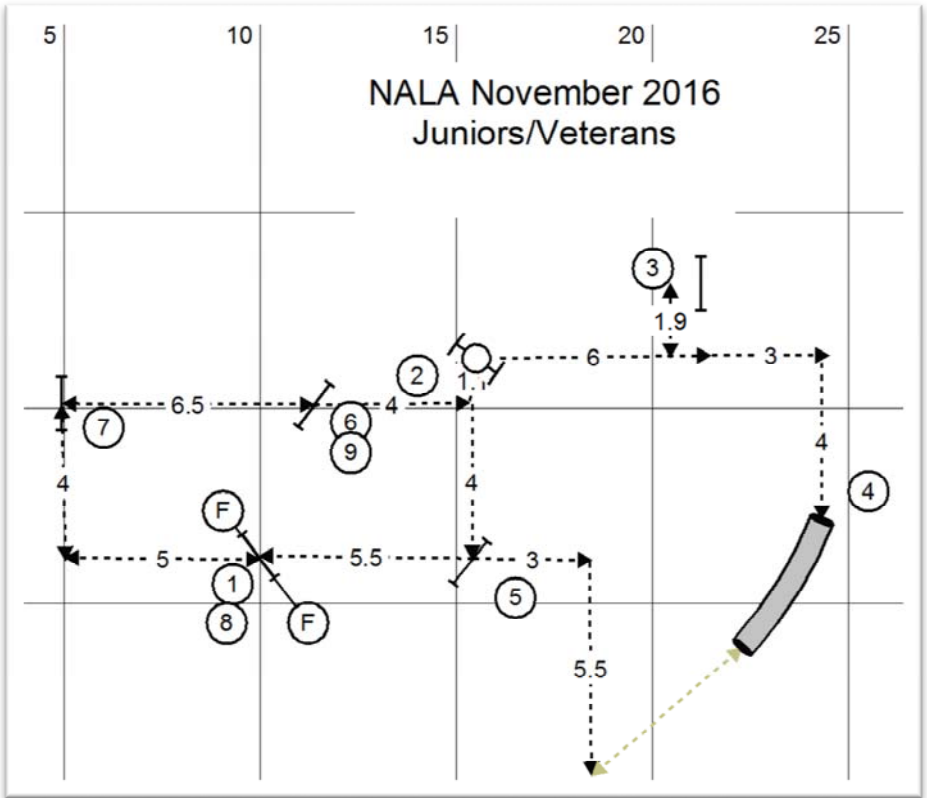

The names of Nala contributors then were a who's who of Agility. Fiona Ferrar, Kathryn Spicer, Deb Jackson, Helen Slater, Carole Logan (Current magazine distributor), Elaine Youthed, Julia Crouch, Fiona

McKennie, Nick Milsum, Ian Gray. But Karen de Wit is still the Editor. This is just absolutely amazing. I take my hat off to this terrific contribution to the sport of Agility. How could anyone do this job for this long. Thank you so much Karen.

Then there is the Editorial, talking about saying it as she sees it, whatever it is and hoping that there are those who will debate it.. My view exactly. The more and different points of view that can be put on a subject the more inclusive the subject becomes, because all of the points of view are valid and many people will agree with all or some of those views. As I have said in many of my Flygility Editorials, 'How off the edge do I have to be to get comment ????? from someone, anyone' It is remarkably rare.

The next thing I notice about the Magazine from Feb 98 is that there are two pages devoted to letters to the Editor. How wonderfully healthy is that. Is there anyone out there that cares enough or has a burning opinion or feels slighted by the system of Nala or Agility or Flygility that could write a few lines saying what it is that they object to/like. Now a lot of people will say that this is now done on the Social media via the Computer. Well I don't agree. Airing your frustrations or congratulations or thanks via the Nala Mag may have a far more lasting impact, especially considering that I still have this copy from 1998.

Does anyone out there actually enjoy NALA? Is it promoted at your Club. My Club is not a Kennel Club Affiliated Group. Nala for us is a Link into competition in the Kennel Club World. I have said to three Clubs now. 'Hey listen we pre-book our Nala days for the whole year on our events calendar for Sundays.. We make sure it doesn't clash with any Flygility or Agility Events, so if your Club struggles to get NALA time why don't you bring your team to us and use our set up. Take your own times away and enter them.'

None of the groups I have spoken to have responded except recently some members of Mt Maunganui came to see what our Nala Flygility was like. The Dog Sports team made them very welcome, gave them some help and they have expressed interest in putting a team together to come and do their Nala Flygility with us. We hope they do and if they commit to it, Dog Sports are happy to put up a trophy for the best team at the end of the Nala year.

It seems that hardly any of the Dog Training Groups in the Bay of Plenty/Central North Island, do NALA anymore. That is a huge shame for their Beginners as it brings a sense of National Competition into their Clubs and works as a tool for encouraging participation in Agility and Flygility. How can we best remedy this issue. Everyone says there is just too much on now, there is so much to go to there is no time for NALA. I think this is extremely shortsighted and if we lose this opportunity because there are not enough volunteers to keep it going and if, heaven forbid, Karen de Wit decides she wants her life back after twenty years of gifted time, we may find ourselves without a wonderful extension of our sport.

Try to figure out how you can have input to this magazine or by submitting Flygility Courses or by writing letters to the Editor or whatever. I have said it before and I say it again, very hard when you feel like you are working in a void. IS THERE ANYONE OUT THERE??

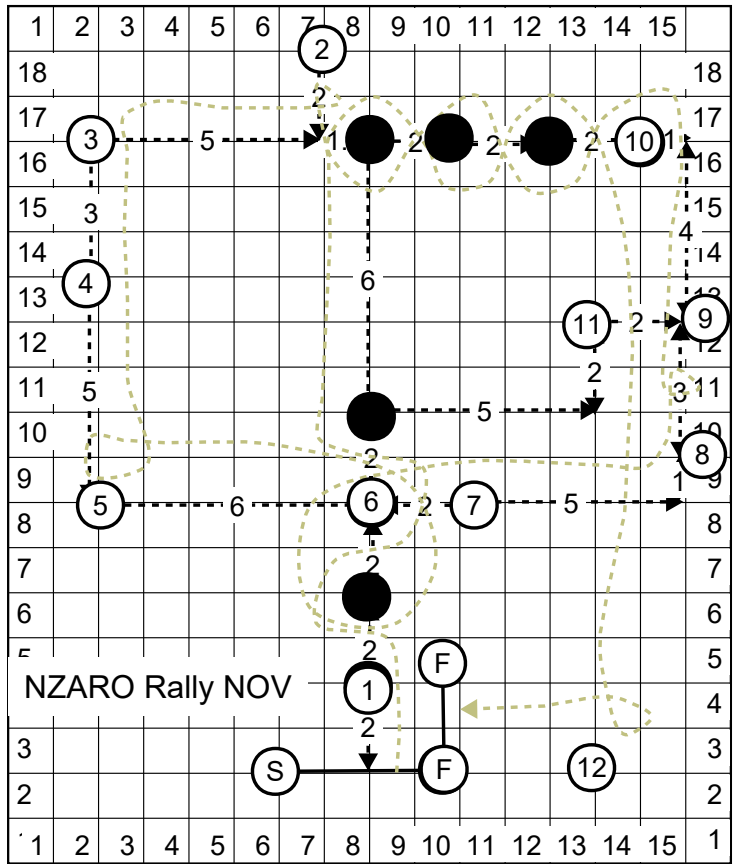

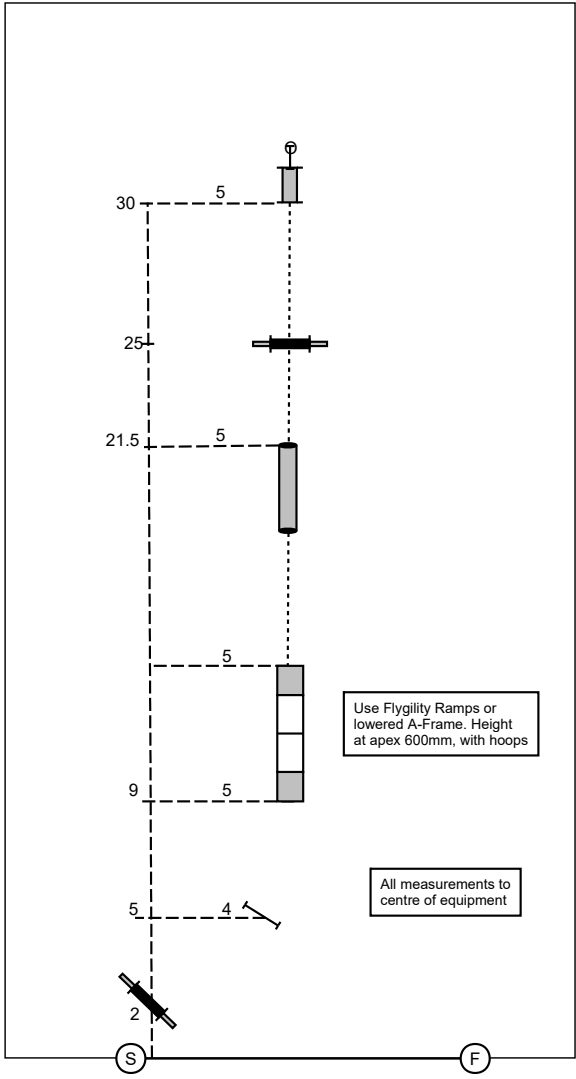

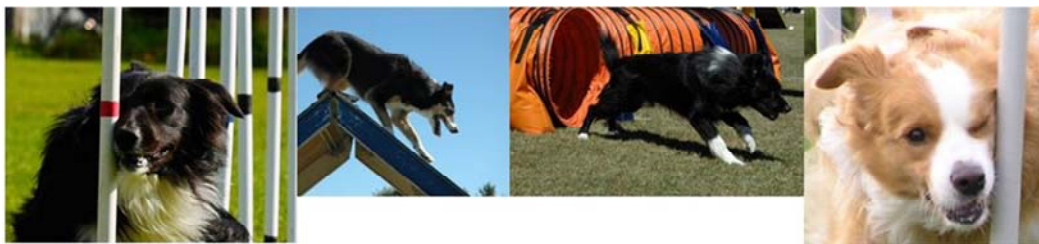
